Prince Stefan of Liechtenstein was born on November 14, 1961 in Klagenfurt, Austria, as son of one of the more distantly related cousins of His Serene Highness the Reigning Prince Hans-Adam II. He grew up on the family estate of Rosegg in Carinthia, Austria. Prince Stefan attended school in Carinthia. Subsequently, he began his business administration studies at the University of Innsbruck, Tyrol, which he completed beginning of 1987 with the degree of Magister (mag. rer. soc. oec.). Following his studies he worked

- from 1988 to 1991 for the Union Bank of Switzerland (UBS) Zurich
- from 1991 to 1995 for the UBS Frankfurt, as director for new issues/investment banking.
- from 1995 to 2001 Prince Stefan led a tourism project on the family estate in Austria, together with one of his brothers.

From June 2001 to Summer 2007 Prince Stefan of Liechtenstein was Ambassador of the Principality of Liechtenstein to the Swiss Confederation. Since March 2007, he is the third Ambassador extraordinary and plenipotentiary of the Principality of Liechtenstein to the Federal Republic of Germany.

Prince Stefan is married. The couple has four children.
